Meat Goat Show Rules

- A. An Exhibitor is limited to showing three animals.
- B. Meat goats must weigh a minimum of 50 pounds and can be up to 14 months in age. Meat goats weighing 49 pounds or less will show in feeder class.
- C. Meat goats must be dehorned, debudded or polled with no fresh wounds at show time. If regrowth has occurred, growth must be less than 1 ½ inches measured from between the horns.
- D. All female meat goats must be tagged with an official USDA identification scrapies tag.

Each showman must show his own animal and will enter the class corresponding to his age. The judge has the right to ask the showman to exhibit abilities to fit animal for showing.
