

BOX BUTTE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN CONTEST

The Queen Committee, Box Butte Co. Ag. Society, and Fair Entertainment Board will be the governing source for this contest.

Rules, Obligations, and Responsibilities of the Contestants and Court:

- Female contestants must be single and between 16-20 years of age.
- If you are or have been married, pregnant or have children you are not eligible.
- If you get married or become pregnant during your reign, you must give up your title and scholarship money.
- Candidates must be a full time resident of Box Butte County, in the Box Butte County school district, or attending and/or have graduated in Box Butte County.
- This is an amateur contest, any contestant that has received any monetary figure for services will not be eligible.
- The talent portion of the contest must not exceed 3 minutes and any props used during this time must be carried on by yourself.
- Be prompt for scheduled events.
- Wear proper attire/coordinated with the fair court.
- No boyfriends allowed, except for escorted events.
- No use of alcohol, drugs, or cigarettes, deliberate acts against the law, or improper behavior.
- Your reign begins Friday and ends the following year. You will receive complimentary tickets to all required events.
- You are expected to attend several parades throughout the year, decided by the Box Butte County Ag. Society.
- Arrangements must be made with your employer and family in order for you to be able to participate throughout the rest of this year's fair and the beginning of next year's.
- Your entry form is official, with the form you filled out accompanied by your signature and guardian's.
- You are responsible on following up on any agreements made during your reign.
- As a member of the Box Butte County Fair Court you cannot compete in another scholarship pageant/contest until you give up your title at the end of the next years contest.
- If you hold a title in another pageant/contest you cannot compete in the Box Butte County Fair Queen Contest
- Events and/or activities will be at the discretion of the coordinator, Fair Board, and of the court.
- If you are unable to attend parades, events, or activities requested, please contact Robyn Iossi as soon as possible.
- You are responsible for assisting in the preparation for next year's contest.

Rules of the Fair Queen Contest must be followed, any violation of said rules will result in dismissal of a contestant or relinquishing of the Fair Queen or a member of the court's title, or scholarship.

A scholarship will be awarded to the queen and her court by the Box Butte Co. Ag. Society and Fair Entertainment Board. Scholarships will be awarded one half at the time of your reign and the remainder at the end of your reign the following year. Proof of attending higher education is mandatory.
